SYNOPTIC SITUATION: Due to steep pressure gradient, strong surface winds are very likely to prevail along and off North and South Gujarat coasts.

Fishermen warning for North Gujarat coast (Jakhau, Mandvi(Kutch), Mundra, New Kandla, Navlakhi, Jamnagar, Salaya, Okha, Porbandar):

DAY 1- Squally weather with wind speed 45-55 kmph from mainly south-westerly direction. Wind speed in gust may temporarily reach to 65 kmph from mainly south-westerly direction. Sea will be rough from mainly south-westerly direction along and off North Gujarat coast on 14th August 2022.

DAY 2- Squally weather with wind speed reaching to 40- 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph very likely to prevail along and off North Gujarat coast on 15th August 2022.

DAY 3- Squally weather with wind speed reaching to 40- 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph very likely to prevail along and off North Gujarat coast on 16th August 2022.

Fishermen warning for South Gujarat coast (Muldwarka, Veraval, Diu, Jafraabad, Pipavav, Victor, Bhavnagar, Alang, Bharuch, Dahej, Magdalla, Daman):

DAY 1- Squally weather with wind speed 45-55 kmph from mainly south-westerly direction. Wind speed in gust may temporarily reach to 65 kmph from mainly south-westerly direction. Sea will be rough from mainly south-westerly direction along and off South Gujarat coast on 14th August 2022.

DAY 2- Squally weather with wind speed reaching to 40- 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph very likely to prevail along and off South Gujarat coast on 15th August 2022.

DAY 3- Squally weather with wind speed reaching to 40- 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph very likely to prevail along and off South Gujarat coast on 16th August 2022.

High Wave Warning by INCOIS

High waves in the range of 3.5 – 5.8 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 13-08-2022 to 23:30 hours of 15-08-2022 along the coast from Jakhau to Diu Head of Gujarat coast.Current speeds vary between 72-129 cm/sec.
